1. Activities reflecting the goal and objectives of the institution :

Being a full-fledged commerce college, we have accepted the challenges of the society to produce marketable graduates as per need of the industrialized society. We are trying our level best to cope up with the changing environment by developing the potentialities of the students.

Add-on courses were introduced in the departments of Accountacy , Computer Applications and Business Management for the students at the undergraduate level.

A one day, computer workshop was organized by the computer department on 18th August, 2007 for the B.Com 3rd year students to demonstrate how to access Internet.

30 Financial aid to students:

- i) The college granted an amount of Rs. 10,080 as financial aid to fourteen no. of students during the year.
- ii) The college "Book Bank" has the provision of lending books to the economically backward students.

31 Activities and support from the Alumni Association:

A meeting was organized with the alumni in the college campus to discuss various academic matters for the development of the institution. The meeting also discussed about the infrastructural development of the college. The alumni expressed their satisfaction on the completion of the Girls' common room. The alumni also stressed on the early completion of the incomplete boys' common room. They expressed their intents of offering a supporting hand towards the institution in near future.

In the parent teachers association meet, the meeting resolved to implement the remedial classes for weaker section of the students. Performance of students is also discussed in the meeting.

(a) A Blood Donation & Group testing camp was organised in the college on 11th sept. 2006. Dr. Balin Khargharia delivered a valuable lecture regarding donation of blood. More than 10 students donated blood and about 200 students got tested their blood group for recording their name in blood donors list.
