The Chairperson welcomed all present in the meeting and requested the Coordinator, IQAC to proceed with the meeting.

Agenda Item No. 4:

To read out and confirm the minutes of the last meeting of IQAC held on December 30, 2020.

As per the agenda, the proceeding of the 8th IQAC meeting was read out by Ms. Prerana Sarma, Department of Accountancy. The minutes was approved after incorporating the minor corrections and suggestions.

Agenda Item No. 5:

Discussion on the activities already carried out by the IQAC and its Committees (from01/01/2021 to 02/04/2021)

- i. On February 06, 2021 Founder Principal Madhav Chandra Chakraborty Memorial Lecture was organized on the occasion of the 56th Foundation Day of the College. The topic of the lecture was "New Education Policy, 2020 and the Future of Higher Education in India" and the Speaker invited was Dr. Nurul Amin, Associate Prof., J.B. College (Autonomous), Jorhat. There were 300 participants in the event consisting of retired Principals of the College, retired Faculty, invited guests, alumni of the college and current students and teachers. Plans and Projects for AQAR 2021 by the respective Sub-committees

National/International Seminar on IPR Bringing out a College Journal with ISSN

I. Dr. K. Chetia, Convener of Curricular Aspects Committee reported that an Online Poetry Recitation Competition was conducted on 21st March 2021 in association with DELVESS (Department of English, Literature, Values and English Studies Society) on the occasion of World Poetry Day. Further, he informed that a Workshop on developing Entrepreneurship Skills for students is going on in association with AAU (Assam Agricultural University), Jorhat. He also remarked that the collecting of feedback from Alumni regarding curriculum is in the process. Dr. Chetia also said that there is a plan to run a Photography Course for students as skill development project. Principal, Dr. Ranjit Sarma informed that the Dibrugarh University will most likely give the green signal soon to open regular M. Com. Program in the college.

II. The Teaching, Learning & Evaluation Committeenext gave their update on activities carried out by them. Joint Convener, Mrs. Rupasree Dutta informed the house about the SSS (Student Satisfaction Survey) done online for the first time for B.B.A. and B.Com 3rd Sem. Students. The SSS was done by preparing a Google link and communicated to the students via the College App. A total of 160 responses were received. The Student Mentoring System is being continued and Mentees are segregated for each Teacher for the New Session students of B.Com 1* Mrs Dutta also stated that on February 10, 2021 the Sem. and B.B.A. 1" Sem. TLE Committeeconducted a Motivational Seminar by collaborating with KU (Kaziranga University) and said that 60 students participated from B.Com & BBA. S. Borkotoki of KU gave a talk on Career Advancement. She further informed that the Teachers Feedback form is ready. She mentioned about the technical difficulties of collecting the feedback online and was thinking of distributing the hard copies of the questionnaire to the students during the upcoming exams. The committee is also planning for remedial measures for students based on feedback received from students (37 students responded) by joining hands with Students



Support and Progression Committee. Topics/ Problem areas are collected from students for giving remedial classes to Advanced as well as Slow learners.

On their future plan, the committee will work on the key indicators of the TLE criterion. Soft Skills course will be conducted for 6th Sem. Work on examination Reforms will proceed once LMS is ready by the College. At this juncture, Dr. Ranjit Sarma, Principal, put forward the suggestion to conduct a Short Term Prog. on Eresources and Techniques.

III. Dr. K. Chetia was handed over the charge of Research Innovations & Extension recently as Dr. G. Deka has joined another institution Dr. Chetia informed that faculty of the College has fewer publications in SCOPUS and H-Index journals and we need to work on it. He also remarked that the signing of MOU with KU was a step in the right direction. He also said that we need more collaboration with NGOs and other organizations for Extension work such as with NCC & NSS, Parivartan, Rotary etc. and that Link ups are required for Internship Progs. Dr. Chetia also said that work is on to conduct a national level FDP on Intellectual Property Rights for Academia in collaboration with CSIR-IICT, Hyderabad. Also, the IQAC coordinator informed that she is planning to bring out the second volume of *Divergence*, an assortment of inter-disciplinary research articles, with ISBN.

IV. The Infrastructure & Learning Resources Convener, Mr. Rupam Sarmah remarked on the unavailability of latest Tax Reference books as per latest syllabus from feedback received from students of his department. Mr. Sarmah further informed that functional computers are 9 or 10 in number in the computer lab and students taking up e-commerce find it difficult to manage. Mr. Rubul Saikia, who is the Computer Science Teacher, also nodded in agreement. Principal Sir agreed that new computers should actually be added annually.

Mr. Sarmah further informed the house that the work of Green Auditing is completed and only the naming and sticking of the labels of scientific names, local and common names on the stems/trunks of trees are to be done.

Dr. Ranjit Sarma, Principal and the Chairperson of the Committee invited suggestions from the members present in the house on how to implement the WiFi provision to the students, whether a Wi-Fi zone can be created in the college campus etc. The Co-ordinator IQAC, Dr. Neeta Lagachu (Taye), suggested if WiFi can be made available to the students on an hourly basis class-wise Mr. Saharia put forward that there is a system to register the mobile nos. in the server. He spoke out about the importance of IP address in this connection. The IQAC Co-ordinator requested Mr. P. Mandal to explain briefly on the methods of accessing data in the campus. Dr. Neeta requested Mr. Rupam Sarmah to keep a record of the extra/remedial classes he gives to students in the department when requested. In this regard, the TLE committee was asked to do the needful and get in touch with Mr. Sarmah.

V. The report of Student Support & Progression Committee was presented by its Convener, Dr. Nitu Konwar. He mentioned and lauded the initiative of the



Innovation, Entrepreneurship, and Career Guidance Cell (IECGC) team in conducting the Instant Chain Story Writing Competition. Next, he appreciated Mr. H. Das on his initiatives to conduct a Workshop on Rongali Bihu Dance. He also happily stated that after a long hiatus, the Alumni had conducted a meeting with the initiative of Dr. U. Dutta, the Vice Principal of the college. Dr. Konwar informed that a program for the benefit of girl students of the college will be organized on World Health Day- April 7. He also mentioned about the 2 students being selected in the Tech Mahindra Campus Placement hosted by Kaziranga University (K.U).

The Convener of SS & P committee, who is also the Assistant Coordinator of the IQAC of the College, apprised the house that they are also planning to conduct a PTM as soon as classes begin for the new academic session. It is also thinking of another Talk/Prog. on gender issues and a Beautician course. About the Beautician course, the IQAC Co-ordinator remarked that it should be made a yearly program as Training Experts are also easily available and it is a never dying art. The Principal responded that it can be done.

VI. In his report on Governance, Leadership and Management Committee, Convener Dr. Sarat Borah stated that External Academic Audit is required to be done. Dr. Borah said that the management should give recognition for motivating employees such as Employee/Teacher of the year and criteria to be fixed for selection. Also there is not much cost involved. He also talked at length of conducting more webinars for the benefit of the college. The Principal remarked about the numerous benefits of My Class Campus App the college is using since Dec -19. It is a very effective management tool and by paying some more amount, added features of the App can be used for greater benefit of the student community. Currently, Rs. 130/- is being paid per student, by the institution. for the use of the College App.

VII. Then followed the report of Institutional Values & Best Practices Committeepresented by Joint Convener, Mrs. Mallika Das. Mrs. M. Das spoke about an initiative titled "Treat to the Wall" in the canteen and the Chairperson/Principal said that it can be taken up as soon as possible. The Principal suggested to the committee that a best practice on Cyber Crime or Women's Legal Rights Progs/ Initiatives, or both, can be taken up. Mrs. Das announced that from this year they have thought of a Best Practice titled "Pranaam" in which they will be visiting an Old Age Home during the time of the 3 Bihus that is observed in the state. The IQAC Co-ordinator put forward her suggestion that the aged ladies of the adopted villages of the college can also be the recipients of the above Best Practice.

Finally, in the discussion on 'any other matter', Dr. H. Das spoke of the need of conducting programs to strengthen cultural cohesiveness.
