A Student Satisfactory Survey (SSS) was conducted by TLEC for the session 2018-2019 among 225 students of B.Com III Semester class. A questionnaire consisting of 19 questions was designed and distributed. Out of the total respondents, 24% of them did not return the questionnaire. 5 point Likert Scale is used for collection of data: i.e. (SA=Strongly Agree, A= Agree, N=Neutral, D=Disagree and SD=Strongly Disagree. A separate column is kept to show no response (NR) from the respondents. After the analysis it shows 68% of the respondents strongly agreed that IA marks are displayed in departmental notice board, 42% of the respondents strongly agreed that assignment work is Properly evaluated whereas 16% of the respondents remained neutral. 38% of the respondents opined that there is fairness in internal evaluation. Only 4% of the respondents strongly agreed that ICT are used in the college followed by 6.7% that totally disagreed, whereas 1% of the respondents did not respond to the question, 4% of the respondents opined that student centric methods are used followed by 12% that totally agreed and 34% opined neutral. 18% of the respondents agreed that Mentoring process is satisfactory followed by 6% that disagree whereas 3% of the respondents did not respond to the question and 29% strongly agreed that overall quality of TL in the college is satisfactory followed by 0.4% that strongly disagreed, 16% remained neutral.
