A Student Satisfaction Survey was conducted by TLEC for the session 2018-2019 among 14 students of **BBA Semester III class**. A questionnaire consisting of 16 questions was designed and distributed, a 5-point Likert Scale is used to analyze the data i.e. SA=Strongly Agree, A=Agree, N=Neutral, D=Disagree and SD=Strongly Disagree. A separate column is kept to show the No Response (NR) from the respondents. From the Survey it shows that 36% of the respondents strongly agreed that students teacher relationship is very good followed by 14% that strongly agreed that there is enough scope for co-curricular activities, 86% of the respondents agreed that assignment work is done fairly, 14% remained neutral, 93% of the respondent strongly disagreed that ICT is used in the classroom, and 7% remained neutral, only 7% of the respondents agreed that post-evaluation Counselling is done whereas 93% disagreed, 29% of the respondents agreed overall quality of TL is satisfactory followed by 57% who remained neutral and 14% that strongly disagreed.
