REPORT

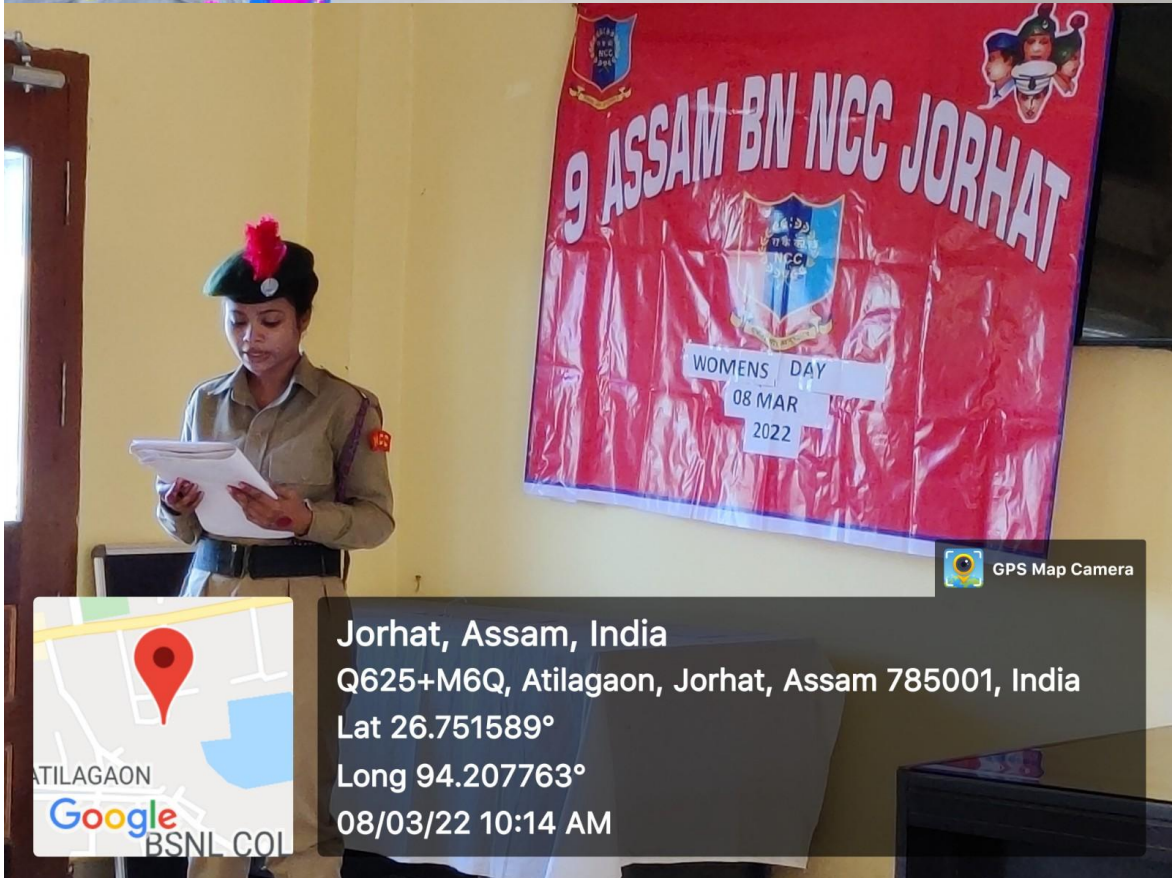

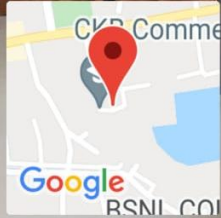

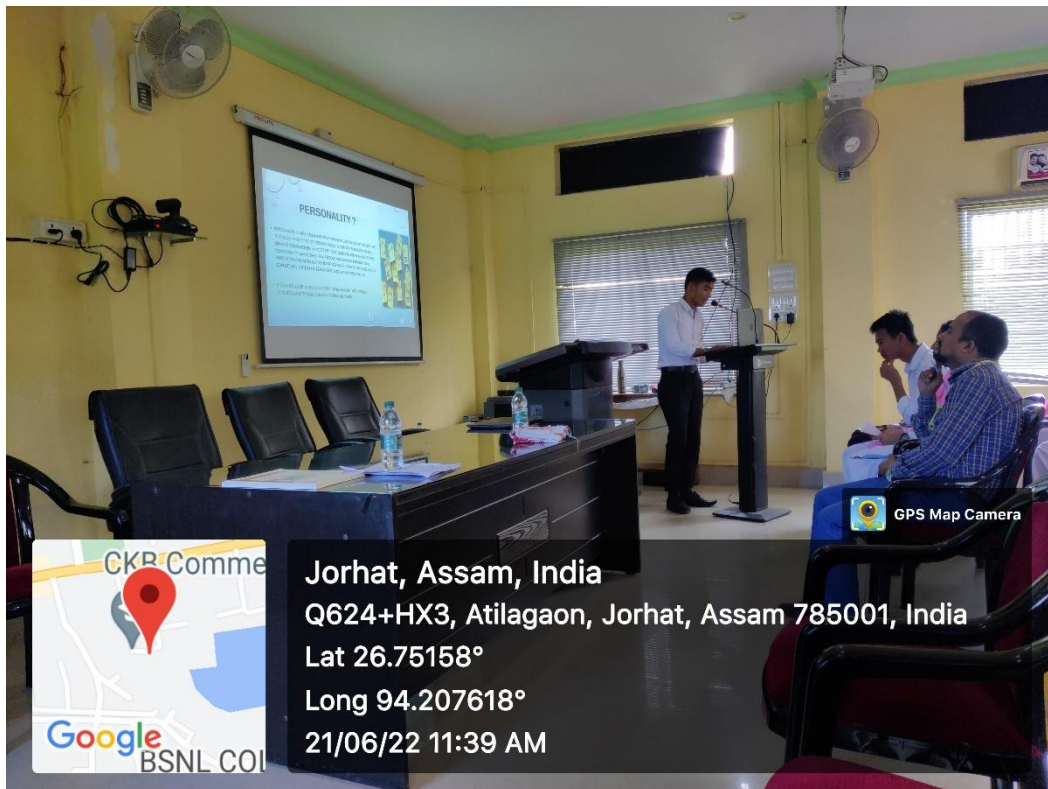


REPORT
