Activities Undertaken:

I. On June 5, 2022 (Sunday), World Environment Day was celebrated by CKB Commerce College, Jorhat along with the whole globe. The celebration was conducted through a series of plantation programs in four schools namely Konwari Pukhuri Public High School, 130 No. Namoni Gaon Primary School, 132 No. Konwari Pukhuri Primary School and Naam Jamuguri L. P. School, and in a Naamghar named Pangiriya Gaon Bornaamghar, in Konwari Pukhuri village, all under the purview of the adopted Gram Panchayat of the College. Most of the tree saplings planted, were of different indigenous fruits (such as Mango, Guava, Berry, etc), tissue cultured, and having very high quality. The initiative was taken by the Institutional Values and Best Practices (IVBP) Committee, IQAC in collaboration with AASTHA, NSS Wing and Village Adoption Committee of the College.






